## ≪ Level 2 Formation Course ≪

The Level 2 Formation introduces new themes for the second plane child as well as broadening – the spiral method! – ones already known from the Level 1 Formation. The Level 2 child has new capacities for time and abstract thinking, and is in a sensitive period for social and moral development.

Participants will collaborate in writing album pages, and at the conclusion of the course will have a complete working album for Level 2.

## ≪ Course Objectives ≪

- ❖ To explore the religious nature and the vital religious needs of the 6−9 year-old child;
- ❖ To offer the adult time to hear, reflect prayerfully and consider the biblical and liturgical themes presented to the 6–9 year-old child;
- To broaden the adult's ability to observe and learn from children's spirituality;
- ❖ To offer guidelines and an experience of the Rome model of Retreat for First Confession and First Holy Communion (Fri-Sun, June 26-28, 2026);
- To offer guidelines and support in preparing the Level 2 atrium, making the catechist's album, and materials for the Level 2 atrium;
- ❖ With successful participation in this course you will receive a certificate from the National Association of Catechesis of the Good Shepherd.

I have also been thinking about the "training school," challenging and at times very demanding, that catechesis with the young children provides for us. If this is true, then our direct contact with children can never be abandoned. There is not a time when, having "gone beyond" the point of working with children, we apply ourselves exclusively to the formation of adults. The moment for solely "teaching teachers to teach" will never come, because if we lose our contact with children we will distance ourselves from the most significant source of our own personal formation.
