Calendar Schedule 2027-2028 for Catechetical Instruction, Retreats and Liturgical Celebrations

Period of the Precatechumenate

Participants who have not received the Sacrament of Baptism will need to receive teachings on Faith and Baptism before going through the Rite of Entrance as they will answer questions in that regard. The prayers speak of learning to know Christ and follow Him, therefore, they are to be guided to begin to develop a daily habit of prayer and understand how to live the Catholic Moral Life. Candidates, those who have already been validly baptized, will need to receive teachings on the Sacraments of Confirmation and the Holy Eucharist as they will ask to be accepted for catechetical instruction leading to Confirmation and the Holy Eucharist at the Rite of Welcoming. We teach to the Rites and from the Rites.

Sunday, November 28, 2027: Rite of Entrance and Welcoming

Period of the Catechumenate: Participants are to receive teaching on the Sacraments and Living Life in Christ in preparation for the Rite of Election (unbaptized) and Call to Continuing Conversion (baptized). This will prepare participants to answer the questions they will be asked and understand the intentions of the prayers being prayed for them during these Rites. Retreat on Saturday, February 25, 2028: The meaning of Lent – a time of purification and enlightenment, the Apostolic Church regarding a bishop and his apostolic succession, preparation for the Rite of Election and Call to Continuing Conversion.

Sunday, March 5, 2028: Rite of Sending at the Parish / Rite of Election and Call to Continuing Conversion at Cathedral on the First Sunday of Lent

Period of Purification and Enlightenment: The Elect and Candidates are to receive direction on prayer and the spiritual life. Lent is to be spent much like a Retreat.
